Summer Enrichment Program (SEP) Marketing Toolkit

Background

The Institute for Diversity and Health Equity's Summer Enrichment Program (SEP) is a 10-week, paid internship program for graduate students that are in the process of pursuing an advanced degree within health care or a related field. Students in the program are paired with a health care organization where they benefit from experiential learning, mentorship, networking and the opportunity to learn from experts in the field.

Experienced administrators serve as preceptors and mentors, providing support and career advice as well as critical early-career connections. The Summer Enrichment Program seeks students from underrepresented backgrounds to strengthen the pipeline and build the next generation of diverse executives and leaders in health care.

Host sites are to provide professional development, mentorship, training and education for interns that are placed at their organization. IFDHE will give preference to host sites that are committed to diversity, equity, inclusion; and have the commitment integrated into their work practices and policies.

The intern & host site application cycle is open from Nov. 13, 2023 – Feb. 2, 2024.

Benefits for students

- **Professional Development** Participants work with experienced administrators that provide support, career advice and the navigation skills needed to excel in their careers.
- **Mentorship** Mentors are a valuable part of one's career growth. Participants will benefit from mentors that coach and guide them during and after the 10-week program.
- **Networking** Participants will gain insight from others in the field and build their professional network to make early-career connections.
